Schedule for Remainder of Term RD115 Spring 2009 MW Class

<u>WEEK 8</u>

 - o Students needing extra time to complete the extra credit essays on the quiz may stay after class to do so

- We will begin the topic of Critical Thinking (Ch. 9); you will also do Ch. 9 in the vocab book (last assignment from that book!) and pp. 178-198 from *Part-Time Indian*.
- The homework packets for this material will be broken into three parts: Assignment Packets 8, 9, and 10.
- □ Begin 8th Assignment Ch. 9 Packet 1 (green)
- Begin Big Extra Credit Project No. 2, also worth up to 100 points, covering material from the whole term, with an emphasis on Chs. 8 & 9. It will be due on the last regular day of class (June 3).
