
BRAINSTORMING BY LISTING & GROUPING

This prewriting method is useful if, when you are beginning to think about your topic, important words and phrases come to mind, without any real order or relationship at all. Just begin writing down key words or phrases in the arrows to the left. Then, try to move those words and phrases in some kind of logical groupings over to the columns to the right. Supply column titles if you can. Feel free to add more words or phrases in the arrows and to add more columns in the groupings to the right.
