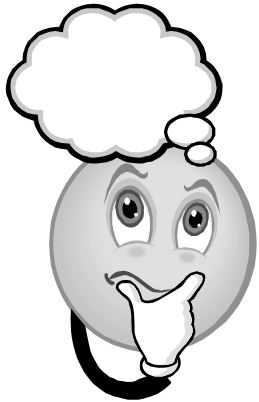


# BRAINSTORMING BY LISTING & ORDERED GROUPING

This prewriting method is useful when you are beginning to think about a topic that involves some sort of ordered process. As with other brainstorming techniques, begin by listing important words and phrases that come to mind over to the left, although *not necessarily in any particular order*. Next, transfer the words and phrases to the graphic organizer on the right, placing them in the appropriate relationship to one another in groups of chronological order and/or relationship (first, second, third, etc). Feel free to add more words or phrases in the arrows and to the groupings to the right.
